Day 1 Guests join the Super Yacht Platinum in the heart of historic Hobart and prepare for a voyage of exceptional tastes and magnificent sights. Platinum departs Hobart on a voyage down the Derwent river and into the D'Entrecasteux Channel. Originally named after the first French explorer to sail through this sheltered waterway, the D'Entrecasteux Channel is now the hub of Tasmania's aquatic adventure sports such as sailing, kayaking and boating. This diverse region houses an eclectic mix of artisans, crafts people, wineries and producers of some of Australia's finest fresh produce.

In the afternoon Platinum anchors off Peppermint Bay Restaurant. Widely recognised as one of the best restaurants in Tasmania, Peppermint Bay offers a unique Tasmanian dining experiences for all Platinum guests with breath taking panoramic views over Bruny Island and the D'Entrecasteaux Channel.

Day 2

The next morning Platinum cruises the spectacular coastline of Bruny Island. Anchoring in Adventure Bay start off a day of discovery on this magnificent piece of coastline. Guests are treated to 3 hours with Bruny Island charters taking an up close view of this amazing coast. This multi-award winning three-hour eco-adventure cruise takes guests through some of Tasmania's unspoilt coastline including the awesome 'Breathing Rock', the towering 'Monument' and the lush emerald green forests of South Bruny .



After this unforgettable journey, guests return to Platinum knowing they've been involved in a remarkable

voyage of discovery – not just Tasmania's best, but simply one of the world's great

In the afternoon guests venture ashore for some time to explore Bruny Island, with nature walks, spectacular scenery and boutique shops and café's there is something for everyone ashore, including a visit to the world famous fudge factory. Day 3 Today Platinum journeys up the Huon Valley, stopping off at many of the unique and eclectic coastal towns such as Cygnet. Here guests have the chance to appreciate the wealth of arts and crafts talent by visiting some of the local galleries. Platinum then cruises the Huon river north to Huonville. Here guests visit one of the Huon Valley's family-owned, multi award-winning boutique wineries, Panorama Vineyard. Specialising in Pinot Noir, as well as producing Chardonnay, Merlot, Riesling, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sauvignon Blanc and a Pinot Rose guests will have a private wine tasting with the wine maker.



Huonville is home to Tasmania's Atlantic Salmon farming industry, along with having an up close look at the farming process, the evening's meal consists of a selection of fresh caught salmon, local cheeses and Panorama wines. A wonderful evening on board Platinum anchored amongst the big Eucalypts of the Huon Valley.

Day 4 Platinum cruises back down the Huon River Valley and returns to Hobart via the scenic coast of Bruny Island. Guests spend the day enjoying the breathtaking views of this world famous coastline.
